ADMISSION POLICY

This policy is issued to provide a framework for Admissions Procedure to be followed for UG and Doctoral programmes at Yenepoya Institute of Technology affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University (VTU), Belagavi.

SCOPE:

Yenepoya Institute of Technology is a self-financed institute under the auspices of Islamic academy of education (IAE). YIT is approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, affiliated to Visvesvaraya Technological University (VTU), Belagavi, and recognized by Government of Karnataka. The students can be admitted to First year UG courses (BE)), year UG courses (Lateral entry) and Doctoral (Ph.D.) courses as per the guidelines laid down by AICTE and affiliating University (VTU).

ADMISSION NOTIFICATION

UG courses

As per the Government of Karnataka and AICTE admission and eligibility criteria, Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) issues the notification to conduct the entrance test (Common Entrance Test — CET).

For Diploma students, lateral entry for direct admission into second year UG (BE) courses Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) issues the notification to conduct the entrance test (Diploma Common Entrance Test — DCET).

Doctoral courses

As per the Government of Karnataka and AICTE admission and eligibility criteria, VTU issues the notification to conduct the entrance test (VTU-ETR — Entrance Test for Research).

SEAT ALLOTMENT

The following table depicts the seat quota allotment for AIET

ADMISSION PROCESS FOR UG COURSES

CET QUOTA: Based on CET, DCET results, Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA) initiates admission process by issuing a formal counselling notification with all guidelines.

COMED-K QUOTA: Based on qualifying COMED-K entrance test results, admission process is initiated by COMED-K by issuing a formal counselling notification with all guidelines.

MANAGEMENT QUOTA: For admission through management quota, students may approach the institute with a valid score card of any qualifying entrance test (CET, COMED-K, JEE).

KEA conducts verification of all mandatory documents submitted by students to confirm the admission, subsequently Directorate of Technical Education (DTE) approves the same for UG and VTU verifies the same and allots the University Seat Number (USN) to each student.

RESERVATIONS FOR UG STUDENT

The Institute follows the guidelines issued by the Government of Karnataka for reservation categories and admission under three quota which are as follows,

Quota- I: Includes SC/ST/OBC/GM categories accounting for 45% of the total seat allotted through the Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA).

Quota- II: Includes COMED-K merit students without any reservations accounting for 25% of the total seats.

Quota- III: Includes Students without any reservations in Management quota accounting for 30% of the total seats.

STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE (SOP) ON ADMISSION

The Institute follows the guidelines provided by Karnataka Examination Authority (KEA), Department of Technical Education (DTE) for admission under CET, COMED-K, DCET, and Management quota.

The below standard process is followed for ease of admission into the Under Graduate (UG) courses .Prior to the start of academic session, the admission process is initiated. The institute shall drive a campaign for admission through advertisement in newspapers, digital media, sharing of prospectus, brochure and pamphlets to the candidates.

Candidates joining under CET quota, shall follow the KEA seat allotment process and complete the admission process to First year BE course by reporting to YIT with admission slip issued by KEA.

Candidates joining under COMED-K quota, shall follow the COMED-K seat allotment process and complete the admission process to First year BE course by reporting to YIT with admission slip issued by COMED-K

Candidates joining under Management quota, shall approach YIT with their valid CET, COMED-K, JEE score card to complete the admission process to First year BE course. In case candidates have not appeared in any of the former mentioned qualifying entrance tests, the institute shall conduct a Management Entrance Test and complete the admission process according to the rank list.

Candidates opting to lateral entry (II year BE — III semester onwards) under DCET quota shall follow the KEA seat allotment process and complete the admission process to Second year BE course by reporting to YIT with admission slip issued by KEA.

For Admission to Doctoral Programs at the VTU research Centres of YIT, the candidates shall follow the admission regulations* laid down by the Visvesvaraya Technological University, Belagavi pertaining to doctoral programs.
